

## Welcome to Ellie's Haven

**The following is a guide to local places to eat that have wheelchair access, places to visit, a few helpful websites and pieces of information.**

---

Duloe is a small pretty village in Cornwall close to Looe and Polperro. Within the village there is a social club with a bar, a pub/restaurant, village stores with a post office and a church, all of which are within a 10-minute walk of Ellie's Haven.

The Marque Bar at the Jubilee Centre at the far end of the village has a bar and various games including indoor bowls. It is open from 19:30 till late. Children and dogs are welcome and there is wheelchair access. Tel: 01503 264940

The Plough is a pub which serves food and has a small garden area although unfortunately does not have wheelchair access.

### **Places to eat with wheelchair access**

We recommend that you check availability and suitability for your likes and needs and maybe look at reviews on sites such as Trip Advisor: although one should always be guarded about comments on such sites, they do give an idea of the menu where the eatery does not have its own website. ### Other Local Places to Eat

#### Talland Bay

About 3 miles out of Looe is a small beach with a café with car parking available either on parts of the road or in private car parks at the two cafes and the hotel.

Editor's note – A personal favorite in a lovely setting with glorious views out to sea across a garden which has lots of interesting artwork and sculptures such as fairies, pixies, animals etc. The restaurant serves quality meals and snacks with outside tables also available; not cheap but you get what you pay for.

Great for sitting outside on nice days next to pebble beach - open 7 days a week mid-March until the end of October– has own car park but charges for use. - 01503 272088

**Smugglers Rest** - 01503 272259

Snacks and refreshments al fresco - no access to decked eating area with wheelchair, but extensive grassed area with tables – lovely on a nice day. Evening barbecues when the weather is good.

Normally open from Easter to October, no website but info on Trip advisor.



## **Polperro**

This is a beautiful quaint fishing village and well worth a visit. There is a large private car park at the beginning of the village (by Crumplehorn Inn); due to size of streets there is limited street parking and restricted access by vehicle beyond The Ship Inn. There are numerous places to eat and some al fresco but limited access for wheelchairs. Disabled public toilets are available in the village.

## **Parking in Looe**

The main car parks in Looe are run by either Cornwall Council or the Looe Harbor Master. It is always best to check parking regulations as to what they offer in the way of concessions to people with disabled parking badges.

Cornwall Council normally offer extra time, visit [www.cornwall.gov.uk/transport-and-streets/parking/disabled-parking](http://www.cornwall.gov.uk/transport-and-streets/parking/disabled-parking) The Harbor Master car parks in East and West Looe offer no concessions.

**Fore Street, East Looe** - there are yellow No Parking bands on the curb which means there is no parking allowed for anyone outside of designated parking bays. People often park there but can end up with a ticket.

**Marine Drive, Hannafore** - there is lots of free parking all along both sides of Marine Drive.

There is a small store and post office at the far end of Duloe, which is about 10 minutes' walk from Ellie's Haven.

Looe has numerous small shops including two Co-op stores in East Looe, numerous bakeries, two small convenience stores in West Looe, and two small convenience stores in Pelynt. The nearest larger supermarkets are in Liskeard less than 8 miles from Ellie's Haven and includes - Morrisons, Aldi and B&M.
